The Board of Directors select the Charity of the Year – COY, each year from entries submitted to the Association. Applications must be mailed or emailed to TCFA by April 1st. The application should be not more than one page and should include the Charity name, description, mission statement, and a brief discussion of how the charity will use the benefits, if selected.
